THE FESTIVAL

The Tribeca Film Festival is a competitive festival that was founded in 2002 by Robert De Niro, Jane Rosenthal and Craig Hatkoff. The Competition is open to feature-length (narrative/documentary) and short films (narrative/documentary/student films).

The 2017 festival edition programmed close to 100 feature length films, 60 short films, and 30 immersive storytelling projects from 41 countries.

Tribeca also exhibits immersive projects to showcase new forms and uses of media, highlighting innovation across a variety of platforms. These may range from virtual reality projects to cross-platform films, websites, multi-media installations, games and apps.

ELIGIBILITY

Feature Films:

- Films must be more than 40 minutes.
- Films may not have screened publicly in the New York region prior to TFF18.
- Films cannot have had ANY public screening, broadcast, distribution or exhibition before January 1, 2017.
- All entries must be in English or subtitled in English.

Short Films

Shorts must submit directly to the Festival before December 1, 2017. Fees will apply. Student shorts can submit for free by uploading a copy of their student ID.

REGISTERING YOUR FEATURE FILM VIA TELEFILM CANADA

- Complete the eTelefilm "Tribeca 2018" form;
