BACKGROUND

The Beijing International Film Festival (BJIFF) is organized by the Film Bureau of the General Administration of Press, Publication, Radio, Film and Television of People's Republic of China, Beijing Municipal Bureau of Press, Publication, Radio, Film and Television, Huairou District People's Government of Beijing Municipality, Beijing TV Station and Beijing Enterprises Group Real-Estate CO Ltd.

Events held at the 8th BJIFF comprise the **Tiantan Awards** (Competition section), **Out-of-competition sections**, **Film Market** and **Theme Forum**. The **Tiantan Awards** include: Best Feature Film, Best Director, Best Actor, Best Actress, Best Supporting Actor, Best Supporting Actress, Best Screenplay, Best Cinematography, Best Music And Best Visual Effects. The winners of these awards will be announced during the Closing and Award Ceremony.

The Competition section and the Out-of-Competition sections are now accepting international film entries, which respect cultural diversity and display outstanding quality in film making.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

• World premieres and films that have not been presented at any other international film festivals are given priority.

Fiction films that meet the following criteria are eligible for **Tiantan Award** Competition and **Forward Future** sections:

- Fiction films completed after January 1st 2017;
- Films of no less than 70 minutes;

Fiction and animation films that meet the following criteria are eligible for the **Film Panorama** Out-of-Competition section:

- Fiction or animation films completed after January 1st 2017;
- Fiction films of no less than 70 minutes and animation films of no less than 60 minutes;

Films submitted to the **Documentary** Section (Out-of-Competition) should meet the following conditions:

- Documentary completed after January 1st 2017;
- Films of no less than 60 minutes.

All films in languages other than English must be subtitled in English by the entrant.

All films should be available in DCP (Digital Cinema Package).

REGISTRATION WITH TELEFILM CANADA

Deadline to complete the entry form via <u>eTelefilm</u>: **January 22, 2018**.

Each entry must also include the following elements:

- ✓ 2 copies of the completed festival application form, printed and signed (to be send later);
- ✓ 2 multizone DVDs of your film clearly identified;
- \checkmark Screening link in the online form.
