# No Borders 2017 International Co-Production Market

held during Independent Film Week

Submission deadline to Telefilm Canada Completed online application via eTelefilm: May 5, 2017

The preselection process will be conducted by Telefilm Canada. Telefilm Canada will render its decision: **May 12, 2017** 

Telefilm Canada will recommend seven (7) scripts for feature films to the IFP jury in New York. The IFP will accept three (3) Canadian scripts on behalf of Telefilm, a *No Borders Presenting Partner*. Selected producers will receive accreditation for Independent Film Week and four (4) nights complimentary hotel room for one (1) producer (or director) from each of the three (3) projects selected to No Borders.

<u>\*\*New for 2017 - Pilot project for short-form web series\*\*</u> Telefilm Canada will recommend two (2) projects for short-form web series and the IFP jury will select one (1). The selected producer (or director) will receive an accreditation and four (4) nights complimentary hotel room.

No Borders is an international film financing forum that offers producers enhanced opportunities to present partially packaged and/or financed fiction projects looking to raise the balance of their budgets to leading American and international partners.

The No Borders experience is a professional environment in which established producers have the opportunity to present their projects in targeted one-on-one meetings to potential investors, production partners, sales agents and buyers. All attending buyers and investors receive a No Borders dossier before the event—with synopsis, budget, and cast/crew information for each project— there is no blind pitching at NO BORDERS. It is through this synergy that the No Borders Market hopes to foster the financing and production of independent cinema.

No Borders activities are private and by invitation only. All participants, however, also have full access to all Independent Film Week events, including the film conference seminars and workshops, and the market screenings.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION – FEATURE FILMS

To be considered eligible, a script must meet the following criteria:

- 20% or more of project financing in place;
- Budget range: up to to 2.5 million (Canadian dollars);
- Market premiere for the narrative script (not presented at other international financing forums);
- Producers has completed at least one narrative feature film that has premiered at a festival or been distributed domestically or internationally;
- Screenplay is written in English and intended as primarily English-language feature-length fictional film.

# ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION – SHORT-FORM WEB SERIES

To be considered eligible, a project must meet the following criteria:

- 20% or more of project financing in place;
- Applicants must submit a substantial visual sample and/or pilot episode that is in post-production;
- Projects cannot have launched prior to IFP Film Week (September 2016). If the series is in its second season or beyond, the upcoming season cannot have publicly debuted yet;
- Episodes for submitted projects cannot be intended to be longer than 15 minutes in length;
- Projects which have not been sold to any network, partner, studio or website ahead of IFP Film Week will consider in priority.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Eligible Canadian projects will be assessed with the following criteria:

- Projects are selected on artistic merit and the potential of the project to benefit from the No Borders program;
- Creative or financial elements strongly suggest suitability for international marketplace;
- Track record of the attached producer is a chief consideration in the selection of the project.

Telefilm Canada shall seek to maintain an appropriate regional balance, so as to encourage films and distribution and production companies from all regions of Canada. Priority will be given to producers that have not participated in past No Borders.

The IFP's final selection is based on the strength of the script and the project's package and is made at the discretion of the No Borders Manager and the No Borders Selection Team. The above-mentioned criteria are used as a basis for evaluation.

# How to Apply

If you already are an **eTelefilm** user, please <u>click here</u> to fill the IFP No Border form.

**If you are not already registered as an eTelefilm client**, you must first open a permanent eTelefilm account as soon as possible and at least 5 days prior to the May 5, 2017 deadline. Telefilm will then send you a personal PIN. Click on this <u>link</u> for details regarding the procedure, and then you will be able to fill the IFP No Borders form.

#### APPLICANT OBLIGATIONS

#### Online submission procedure

Only the nine (9) applicants recommended by Telefilm Canada to IFP will be asked to complete an Online Submission Procedure with the IFP (Deadline: Wednesday, May 17, 2017).

## Delivery of your script to IFP in New York

**IFP is only accepting screenplays in PDF format**. PDFs of scripts must be submitted through their secure online application. No hard copies are permitted. Your files must be uploaded at the bottom of the online application by clicking "Upload Your Screenplay," at the time you complete your online application. Your document must use commonly accepted screenplay format margins and layouts. Your PDF file MUST be named your script name (FilmTitle.pdf). Your file name should exclude spaces, underscores or punctuation marks, and must contain the extension .pdf.

Scripts must have appropriate registration with the Writers Guild of Canada (WGC) or the Société des Auteurs de Radio, Télévision et Cinéma (SARTEC) or copyright (refer to any popular screenwriting text for assistance). Please attach proof of copyright registration.

### Presence at No Borders

The four (4) projects selected must be represented by their producer for the duration of NO BORDERS (September 17 - 21, 2017).

Selected producers will receive accreditation for Independent Film Week and four (4) nights complimentary hotel room for one (1) producer (or director) from each of the four (4) projects selected to No Borders.

# Survey

The selected producer agrees, after the event, to complete a survey for Telefilm Canada regarding the satisfaction and outcomes of the initiative.
