## **Eligibility**:

- Companies must be Canadian owned and controlled, as defined in the Investment Canada Act;
- Participants must be employed by a private company in Canada;
- Participants' primary activity must be related to the film, television or new media industry.

### **HOW TO REGISTER**

- 1. Complete the Canada Pavilion application form here by May 3;
- 2. For Quebec based companies: upon receipt of the form, the SODEC will ask the MIFA to send you a link to register;
- 3. For companies outside Quebec: upon receipt of the form Telefilm Canada will ask the MIFA to send you a link to register;
- 4. Register with the MIFA to pay and confirm your badge.
